Teach For Nigeria (TFN) is focused on developing a movement of leaders across the nation who are committed to ending educational inequity. In the short term through a two-year Fellowship, TFN recruits Nigeria's most outstanding university graduates and young professionals of all academic disciplines to teach as full-time teachers (as Fellows) in high-need schools in poor communities.

Through this experience, our Fellows gain exposure to the realities of Nigeria's education system and begin to identify their role in building a wider movement for educational equity. In the long term, TFN supports its alumni – equipped with the experience, conviction, and insight that comes from leading children to fulfill their potential – to be a force for change, working from across sectors to expand educational opportunities.

Position Summary

The Development and Partnerships team is responsible for securing the financial and strategic partnerships for Teach For Nigeria, and building and deepening the relationships with donors and champions who support our vision for impact.

Teach For Nigeria is looking for a development and partnership coordinator who will have the opportunity to develop and lead on key resource creation for engagement and cultivation of potential givers, innovate and support the building of partnerships with key stakeholders.

We are looking for someone who thrives in an intense and high pace environment, whilst maintaining careful attention to detail. You will need excellent writing skills. You will need to have knowledge of report and proposal writing. You will be passionate about supporting the process of identifying and engaging donors and partners.

Major Responsibilities

The Development and Partnerships Coordinator will directly report to the Head of Development and Partnerships. Together, they are responsible for securing the financial and strategic resources necessary to advance Teach For Nigeria's vision of impact.

The Coordinator will be responsible for:

- Leading on prospect research in alignment with the Development Strategy and goals
- Designing and managing Development & Partnership tools such as the fundraising calendar and donor cultivation
- Leading on proposal writing, reports, and grant applications as appropriate
- Managing internal communications between the Development and Partnerships team and other key functional units.
- Supporting the unit to ensure that Teach For Nigeria's yearly fundraising target is met by designing and implementing creative fundraising campaigns
- Managing the planning and execution of fundraising-related events

Development Strategy

- Report on goal and priorities status
- Follow up on collaborations with other teams
- Data tracking and analysis
- Lead in cross-team collaboration including Finance, Marketing, Program, and MEL

New Partnership Development

- Identifying and qualifying prospects and opportunities

- Build value propositions aligned with the needs of the organization and impact measurement frameworks alongside the programmatic/finance team
- Building and managing systems for the Dev team (e.i. Playbook Cultivation and Stewardship trackers)
- Capacity to help activate donor engagement activities - logistics, coordination, etc.
- Lead on data capturing from other departments
- Manage Report deadline

Education and Experience

- A minimum of 3 years of professional experience is required in managing processes and systems to help monitor progress./
- Experience in Proposal writing.
- Experience collecting, analyzing, and using data to inform strategic and tactical decisions.
- Experience working and living in Nigeria or in a country with a similar context to Nigeria.

Requisite Skills

- Passionate about our mission and values, believes deeply in the importance of inspiring/investing external people in our mission, and has high expectations for how Teach For Nigeria is viewed by external stakeholders and the general public.
- Excellent organizational and planning skills, as well as immense attention to detail
- Excellent relationship-building skills (listening, negotiating, and reasoning skills)
- Experience in managing fundraising databases (knowledge of Salesforce is preferable)
- Excellent research skills – the ability to locate, process, and analyze publicly available information and data (ability to draw out strategy and goals from research)
- Fluent knowledge of (writing, reading, speaking)
- Extremely strong verbal and written communication skills; can speak and write compellingly about our organization, mission, and goals
- Excellent critical thinking skills, ability to problem-solve and develop opportunities in order to achieve the most meaningful outcomes
